

## REDS

**Angeline “Reserve”, \$7.00/\$35**

### Pinot Noir

Fresh, rich ripe flavors of black cherry, cola and plum layered with a subtle touch of vanilla oak & raspberry.

**Foster IQUE, Malbec \$8.00/\$40**

IQUE is 100% Malbec ruby-red with violet hints in color, it possesses fruity aromas of fresh red fruits and white pepper.

**181 Merlot \$7.50/\$38**

Notes of black cherry, vanilla, stone fruit and toast. Flavors of currant and spicy cedar end with a lingering, luxurious finish.

**Renato Ratti Barbera, \$11.00/\$46**

Rich in body and color, warm and robust....Intense Cardinal red with scents of ripe plum and spice box with a long finish.

**Castle Rock Pinot Noir \$6.00/\$38**

Medium bodied offering rich complex layers of plum, cherry vanilla oak and just a hint of clove and a long velvety finish.

**Palo Alto, Chile \$7.00/\$29**

55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Carmenere, 15% Syrah Full bodied with flavors of black currant, blueberry mint and touch of spice. Notes of cocoa and hints of toast.

**Antano Rioja, Spain \$7.00/\$30**

Medium bodied, this wine has an edge which lends to its raspberry and blackberry with French oak aging adds depth and spicy character.

**Red Tree Pinot Noir \$5.50/\$28**

Ripe richly endowed with red fruits with dominance of mixed berries ripe supple tannins with hints of crushed berries, red currants, vanilla and earth driven minerals. Fine and long finish.

**Grand Cru \$5.50/\$28**

### Cabernet Sauvignon

Bold and full bodies black cherry, dark chocolate and subtle toasty coffee & vanilla notes.

## FINNISH BEERS

**Kataja Olut \$9 bottles**

### Finland

Medium body with little carbonation almost cider-like. Bright sour cherry onset with a spicy finish. Lingering notes of earthy juniper and cardamom yet it's a thin pour. Quite malty with sediment and a tart edge.

**Sinebrychoff Porter \$9 bottles**

### Finland

Heavy medium body, moderate carbonation and a velvety smooth feel. Dark chocolate almost black color and is heavy on the roast, molasses, maple syrup, and brown sugar; some burnt biscuits notes are added, along with just a tiny hint of smoky spruce tips. A very tasty Baltic porter.

## WHITES

**Protocolo Blanco, \$6.00/\$25**

70% Airén, 30% Macabeo

Aromas of fresh fruit, bananas, apples and peaches. Fruity, silky notes with bright acidity, followed by a pleasant, persistent finish.

**L'ermitage Blanc, \$6.00/\$30**

60% Roussanne, 20% Grenache Blanc, 20% Viognier Understated citrus quality and a bit of peaches round and juicy and French vanilla yet finishes dry and a bit dusty.

**Clos la Chance, \$6.50/\$32**

This un-oaked Chardonnay opens up with aromas like a tropical fruit salad—bananas, pineapple, guava, kiwi, lime and a hit of grassiness round out this very fruit forward un-oaked Chardonnay.

**Loredona Riesling \$6.00/\$25**

Delicate aroma's of white nectarine, orange blossom and a touch of honeysuckle. On the palate fresh nectarine mingles with lime, honey dew melon and candied orange peel. Crisp and refreshing.

**Benvolio Pinot Grigio \$5.50/\$28**

Well-balanced with crisp acidity and ripe flavors of lemon, apple and pear. Fruit-forward yet dry and very food friendly.

**99 Vine Chardonnay \$5.50/\$28**

Opens with a light lemon bouquet with a hint of apple and this wine is medium bodied and balanced. The finish is dry and refreshing.

## PREMIUM BEERS

**Tilburg's Dutch Brown Ale \$6 bottles**

**Holland** Sweetish caramel malts, some roastiness and light complexity. Finishes up dry with some tartness and a light honey aftertaste.

**Hacker-Pschorr Hefe Munich Gold \$6 bottles**

**Germany** Taste is very peppery and dry up front, clove-like flavor mostly. Finishes just slightly bitter but relatively clean.

**Paulaner Hefe-Weizen \$6 bottles**

**Germany** Mild yet complex. Nice spice with clove, pepper and coriander. Pleasant fruity quality with tropical sweet banana. Smooth and surprisingly clean with a sweet bread dough finish.

**New Castle Brown Ale \$6 bottles**

**England** Blend of crystal malts creates a light, nutty, malty taste softly balanced by hop dryness.

**Bell's Oberon \$6 bottles**

**Belgium** Light-bodied bubbly and crisp Lots of grassy wheat, lemon, pear, and a touch of spice. A pleasant subtle hop bitterness with a touch of pepper spiciness; also some orange and lemon rind toward the finish

**Hacker-Pschorr Original Oktoberfest \$6 bottles**

Bright, clear honey golden color with a grainy, slightly biscuity aroma and slight malt sweetness. Some slight hop bitterness.
